#### CNPWEB REPLACEMENT - CHANGE REQUEST

 This project objective is to replace an <u>unsupported</u> and <u>functionally</u> <u>ineffective</u> Health & Nutrition seven-program area system, with a <u>full</u> <u>federally-funded</u> vendor-hosted platform solution.

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- Seeking ITAC approval for a change request to increase budget and timeline for the project.
- Today's presentation will summarize what led to this change request and will overview the timeline and budget changes, specifically.

### THE CHANGE REQUEST



This change request:

- does not impact the scope of work, rather emphasizes the vendor's proposed change to their approach in fulfilling the scope of work provided in CTR045646,
  - a. Agile vs waterfall
  - b. Leverages new technology platform
- does impact the go-live date (April 24, 2023), and
- includes increase costs of \$514,207.

## FINANCIAL CHANGES - SUMMARY

- Comparing the Financials provided in the PIJ to the the current proposed SOW and the additional ADE-funded development costs, the overall increase in cost is reflected as \$514,207.
- Essentially the maintenance costs for years 2-5 were "cancelled out" by an increase in development cost and the development cost was spread across 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years instead of one, as explained in the PIJ.
- Revised pricing is largely due to an increase in development hours via Agile methodology instead of waterfall. A deficiency of 11,000 was determined

# A REVIEW OF PROJECTED SUCCESSES

- Leverages the newest technology which is designed to be a configurable solution permitting ADE-HNS to easily add components in the future
- Integrates with existing ADE systems and security and new system will have ability for integration with other potential vendor-built systems or systems deployed by ADE

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- Automates data queries, increase output speeds, and eliminates the need for multiple stand-alone systems and databases
- A standardized, streamlined application format and process will eliminate the need to duplicate data across numerous program areas
- Provides the ability for ADE-HNS to obtain adequate, comprehensive program information at the entity level for all child nutrition programs, applications, compliance reviews, claims and payments; data analytics

### **VENDOR SELECTION & BACKGROUND**

- Colyar Technology Systems (CTS) was the vendor awarded CTR045645 in September 2019.
- JAD meetings with the vendor commenced and it became evident that HNS expected a custom solution while the the vendor was operating with the understanding that they had proposed to provide HNS with a base Commercial Off the Shelf (COTS) version of their CNP software configured for Arizona.
- Requirements were to be completed mid 2020, however CTS experienced corporate growth and all felt impacts from the pandemic which influenced resource/time allocation and the project experienced delays.



### VENDOR PROPOSED CHANGES

- Requirements gathering continued and in September 2020, CTS was acquired by LINQ.
  - This provided CTS greater access to resources, newer technology platforms, and a greater capacity to meet the needs of Arizona's project already under way.

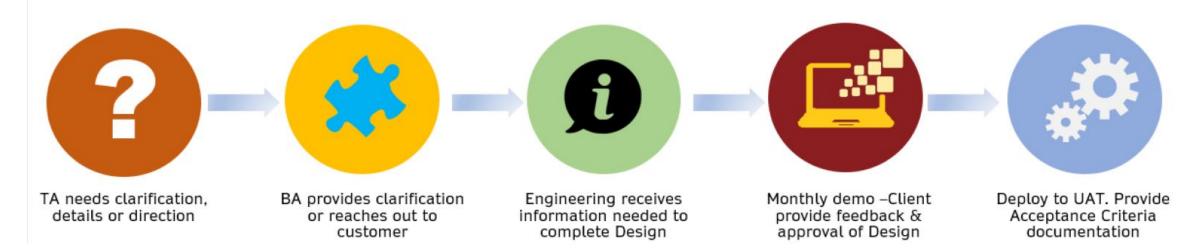
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• The newly unified organization proposed a Statement of Work (SOW) revision to ADE-HNS in June 2021 and revised it per ADE's request in July.

#### THE PROCESS

- The business completed requirements in the spring 2021 and now a new engineering team is conducting a requirement refinement to identify any potential missing details in the requirements and to align for development needed.
- Weekly meetings have commenced with a new engineering team
