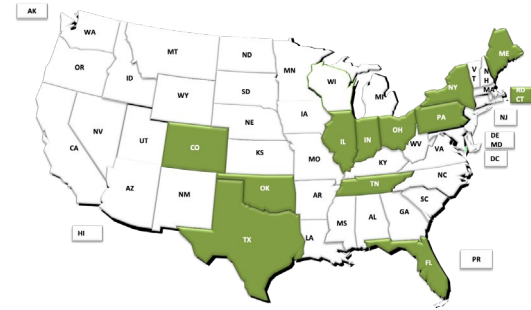

Project Introduction

- A Federal Mandate per Section 1903 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b) requires electronic verification of personal care and home health services:
 - Type of service performed
 - Individual receiving and providing the service
 - Date and Time the service begins and ends
 - Location of the service
- Purpose of EVV includes:
 - Prevent, detect and recover improper provider payments due to fraud, waste and abuse
 - Support access to care planning and monitoring

Chosen Solution – Sandata Technologies

- SaaS Technology
- Vendor with multiple State Medicaid Agencies
- Security compliant
- ADA compliant
- AZ Ramp Certified



Project Change Request Overview

- What in the PIJ is changed?
 - Project End Date changed from 12/31/2021 to 6/30/2022
- What initiated this change?
 - CMS delay in certification for all state Medicaid agencies
 - Time needed to pay remaining bills post certification

Project Timeline

- Go Live – January 2021
- Certification Operation Period
 - Was Jan – Jun 2021
 - Now Jan – Dec 2021
- Certification Meeting w/ CMS
 - Was Aug 2021
 - Now Jan 2022
- Certification approval from CMS
 - Was 60 days
 - Now 100 days (est April 2022)
- Project End Date
 - Was 12/31/2021
 - Now 6/30/2022
