

Security Update - Statistics for the Last 30 Days

<u>Message Delivery</u>: Roughly 17 Million messages were accepted into the State's GSuite environment while roughly 1.6 million were rejected entirely from entering at all.

















Security Update - Statistics for the Last 30 Days

<u>Spam Filtering within State GSuite Environment</u>: Roughly 16 million were delivered into the end users' inboxes while approximately 809,000 were redirected to the Spam folders.


















Security Update - Statistics for the Last 30 Days

Ongoing efforts

- Increasing adoption and usage of Hangouts Meet
 - → Video conferencing app for up to 250 participants
 - → Included with G Suite licensing

- Reduced duplicative licensing by 88% statewide
- Cost avoidance of \$634,320 for FY20
- Cancelling statewide duplicative licensing in FY21



Ongoing efforts

- Training opportunities for agency technical leads and end-users
- Monthly statewide newsletters
- Drive migrations for state agencies
- Revamping Resource Site for ongoing adoption focus
- Re-engaging agency Champions
- Working with agencies to reduce duplicative licensing in other areas
