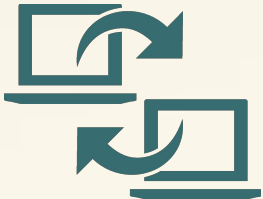

- On April 21, 2020, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the Navigable Waters Protection Rule to define “waters of the United States” (WOTUS) in the Federal Register. This rule changes the existing definition of "waters of the United States" and impacted 6 services in scope for myDEQ FY19 project.
- ADEQ proposes to replace the impacted services with 6 new services from customer prioritized list.
- No impact to the overall budget and schedule. ADEQ still plans to deliver 22 online services to Arizona customers by June 2020.

Prior to receiving any grant funding, State environmental agencies are required to reach annual agreements with EPA on the methodology used to calculate indirect costs. For FY20, ADEQ reached an agreement with EPA for indirect costs "up to 32.49%".

ADEQ applied a 10% indirect rate until January, 2020, when the rate increased to 32.49%.
