Section 1903 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b), as amended by H.R. 6042, mandates that AHCCCS implement an Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) system for non-skilled in home services (attendant care, personal care, homemaker, habilitation, respite) by January 1, 2020 and for in home skilled nursing services (home health) by January 1, 2023. There is no current statewide system that complies with this mandate, requiring that AHCCCS implement a new system to fulfill these requirements.
