Purpose for Change Order

- The Arizona Department of Public Safety (AZDPS) has a current project to replace the existing Computer Aided Dispatch System (CAD) with a new Spillman Flex CAD System.
- Included in the CAD software was a Records Management System (RMS), which at the time of purchase was not going to be utilized.

Purpose for Change Order Cont.

- Originally, development of an Interface between the Spillman CAD and the Department's existing Niche RMS was planned in order to populate the Niche RMS with call information from the new Spillman CAD.
- DPS Command staff has made a decision to utilize the new RMS. The decision to use the new RMS was based on:
 - The age of the Department's existing RMS
 - The existing RMS did not meet some of the needs of both the Highway Patrol and Criminal Investigations Divisions.

Purpose for Change Order Cont.

- The existing RMS did not meet the Department's statistical reporting needs.
- There will be a cost savings in maintenance fees
- Eliminate the need for an interface between the new CAD system and the existing RMS which will allow the Department to use a cohesive suite of products that are built to work together.

Request

- AZDPS is requesting a change in project scope and development costs to purchase 3 software modules in order to use the Spillman RMS.
- There is no anticipated risk of project timeline change and no dependencies or constraints have been identified.
- There will be a minor change in project scope to include the use of the Spillman RMS
